GENERAL OFFICE / CLERICAL SAFETY RULES



BBSI has developed these Safety Rules patterned after Cal OSHA requirements. Read and become familiar with these rules and other safety rules that apply to your job.

- 1. Perform only those duties for which you have been hired to perform.
- 2. Report any unsafe conditions to your supervisor immediately.
- 3. Report all accidents and injuries to your supervisor as soon as practical.
- 4. Do no lift any item in excess of 25 pounds. Use caution when reaching to lift overhead.
- 5. Horseplay is prohibited at all times.
- Report any problems with defective lighting or equipment prior to beginning the work assignment.
- 7. Report any tripping hazards noted in parking lots, stairways, or walkways immediately.
- 8. Neither drugs nor alcohol are permitted on any company job site, property, or vehicle. Suspected job intoxication will be handled according to BBSI's Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 9. Post-accident drug testing will be conducted based upon BBSI's Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 10. Familiarize yourself with emergency planning, evacuation procedures, exits, First Aid facility sites, and fire extinguisher locations.
- 11. Observe all safety warning signs.
- 12. Never us your hand as a hammer.
- 13. Keep all cabinet drawers closed when not in use. Never open more than one file cabinet at a time.
- 14. Keep all aisles and walkways surrounding the work area free of cords, debris, or other tripping hazards.
- 15. When continuous typing is required:
 - a. Stretch your wrists prior to starting the assignment:
 - b. Keep your wrists straight and use wrist pads;
 - c. Your distance from the monitor should allow you to adequately focus on the screen and text;
 - d. Rest your wrists frequently (once every hours); and
 - e. Ensure the screen glare is minimized and the lighting is adequate (no eye strain).
- 16. Familiarize yourself with the hazards of office supply chemicals and the precautions. This information can be obtained in the office copy of the Safety Date Sheets booklet.
- 17. If you are no trained in First Aid response, do not attempt First Aid. Call for help.
- 18. Do not overload electrical plugs. Use extension cords on a temporary basis only.
- 19. Use caution when handling any cutting equipment.
- 20. Should you every have any safety concerns that you have brought up to your supervisor, and the issue is not being addressed, contact BBSI HR.
